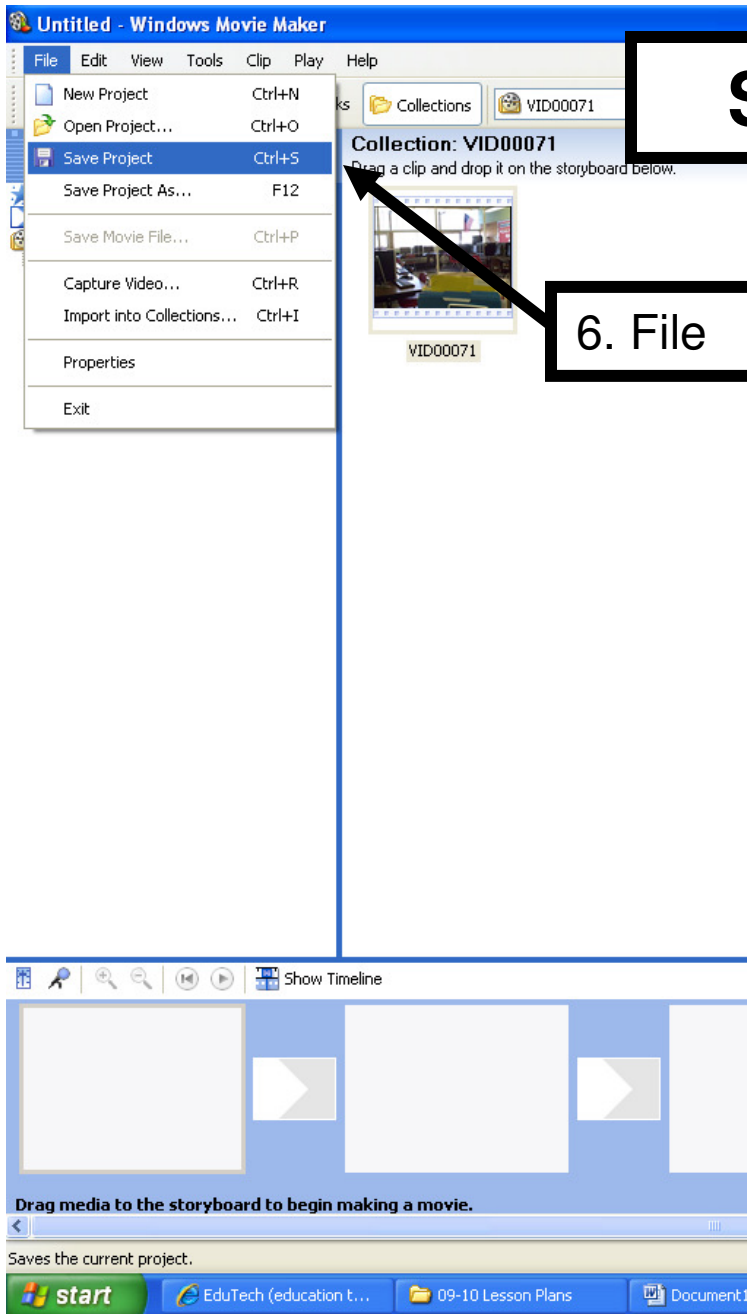


1. *Open Windows Movie Maker*

**File > Import into Collections**

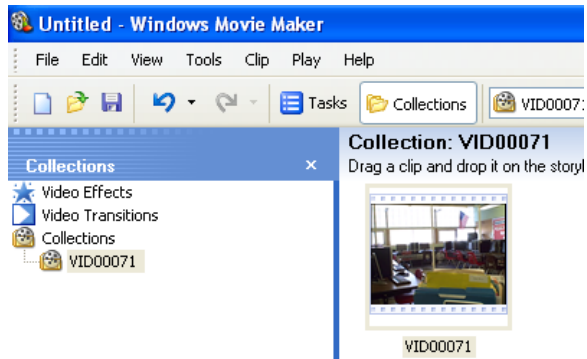
3) *Find folder with video clips*

5) *Drag clips to "Storyboard".*



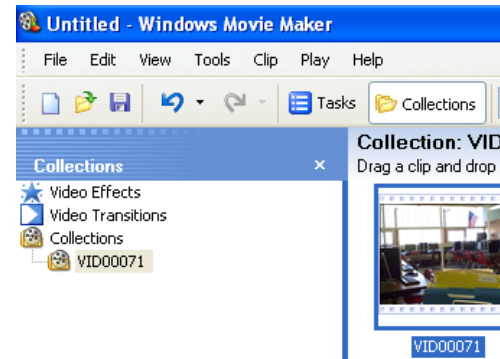
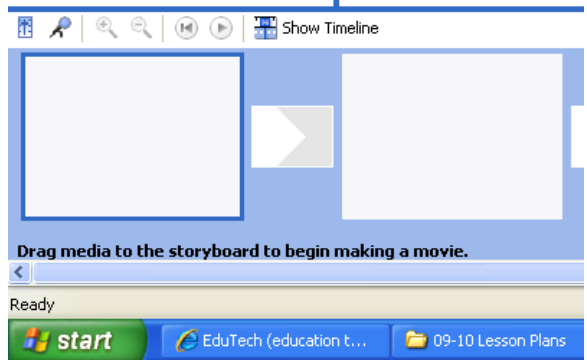
# Save Your Project

6. File > Save Project

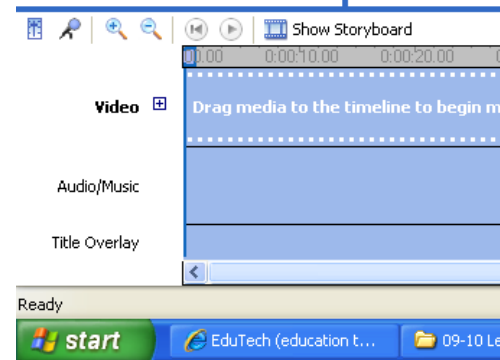
- Save project with the file name:

 Use this view to split clips and delete clips you don't want

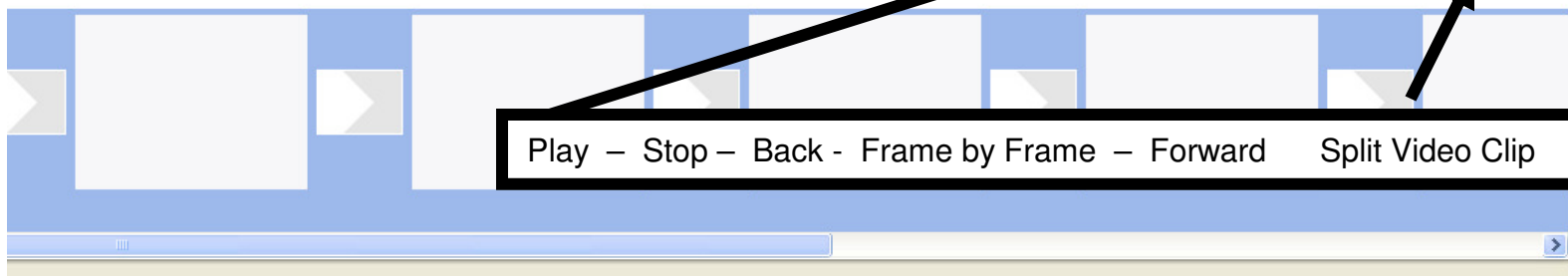


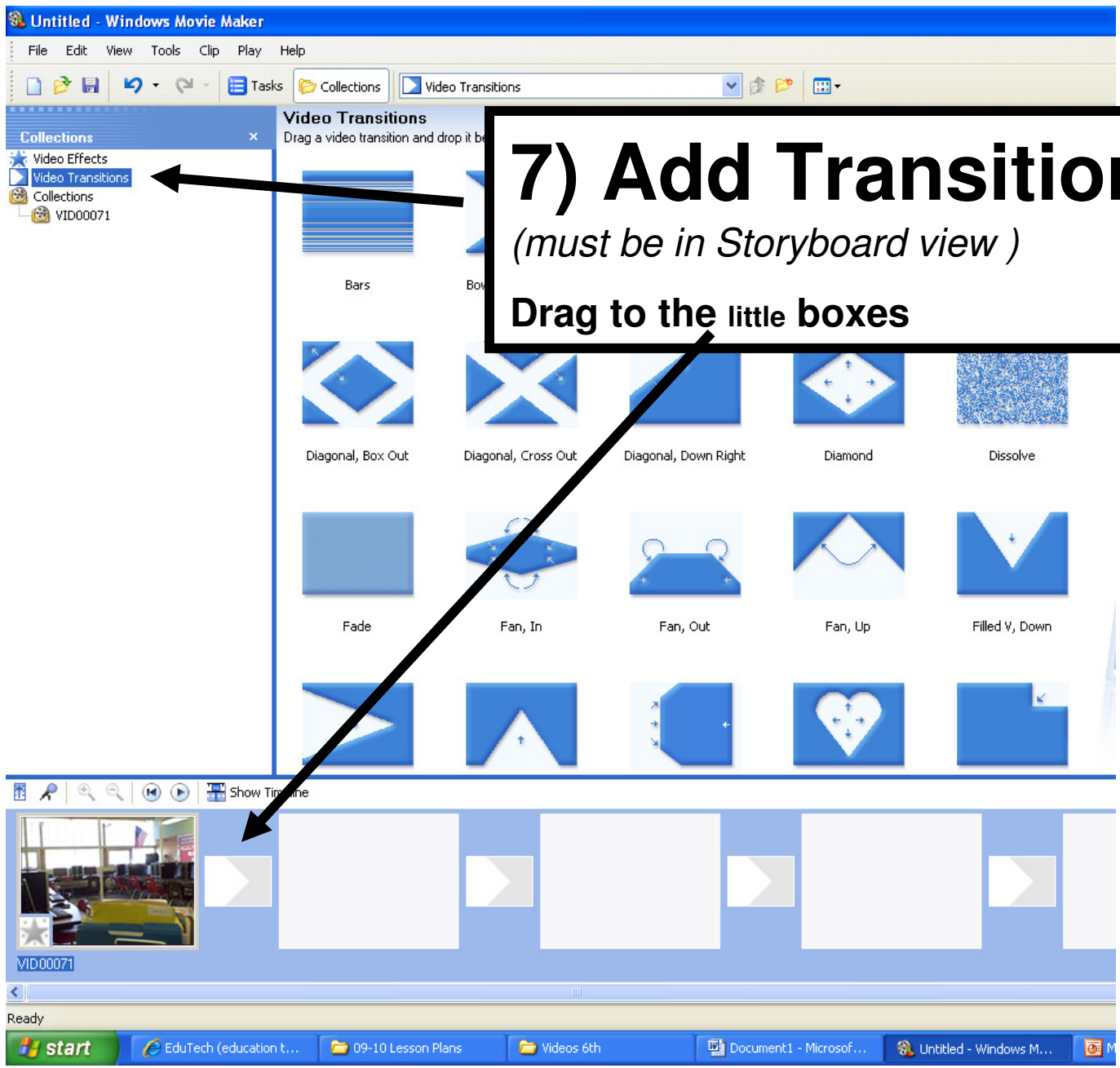

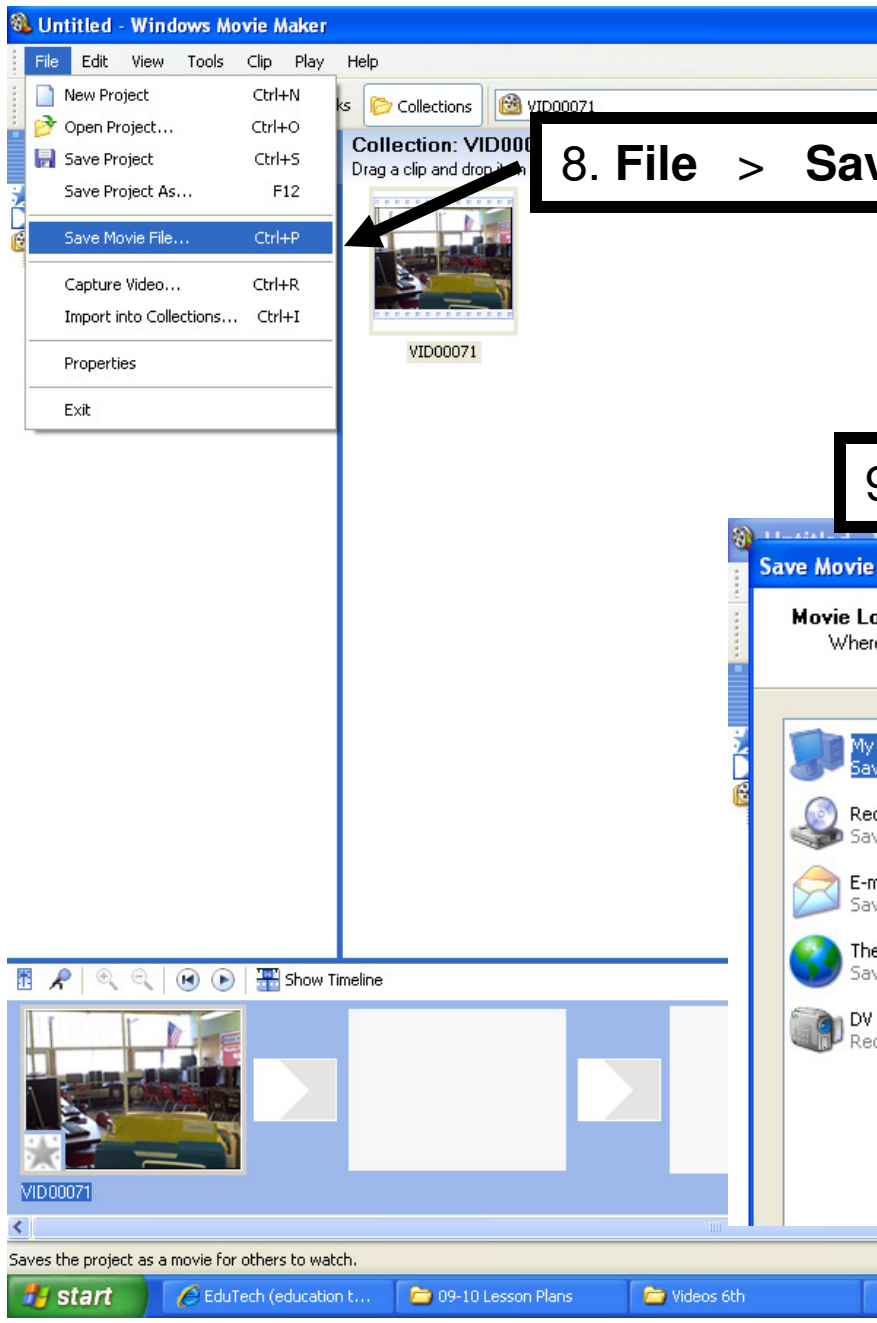


Play – Stop – Back - Frame by Frame – Forward    Split Video Clip





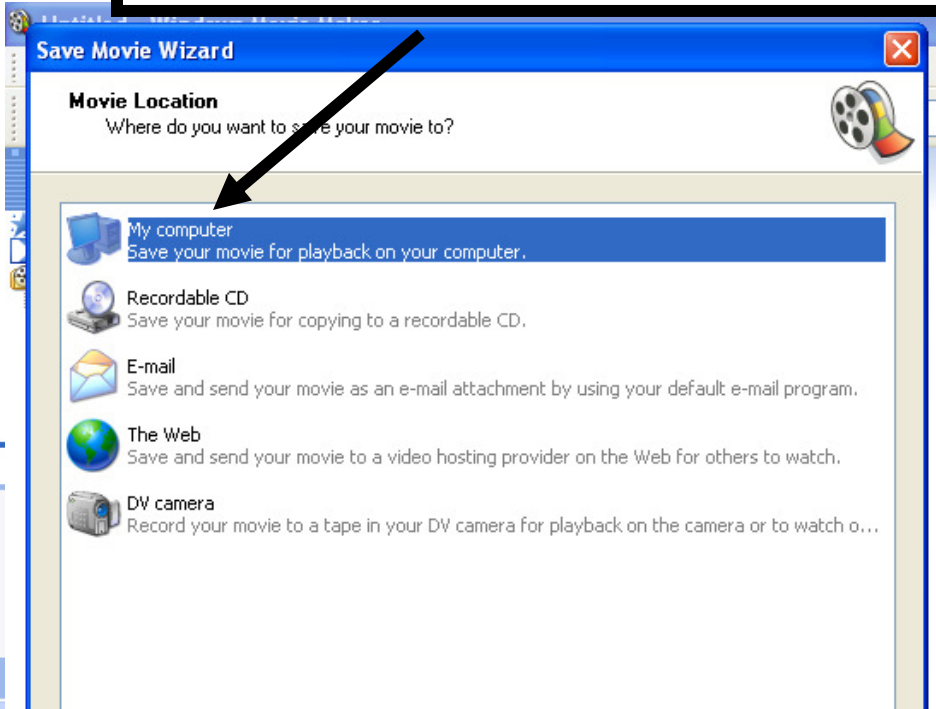
**7) Add Transitions**

**Drag to the little boxes**

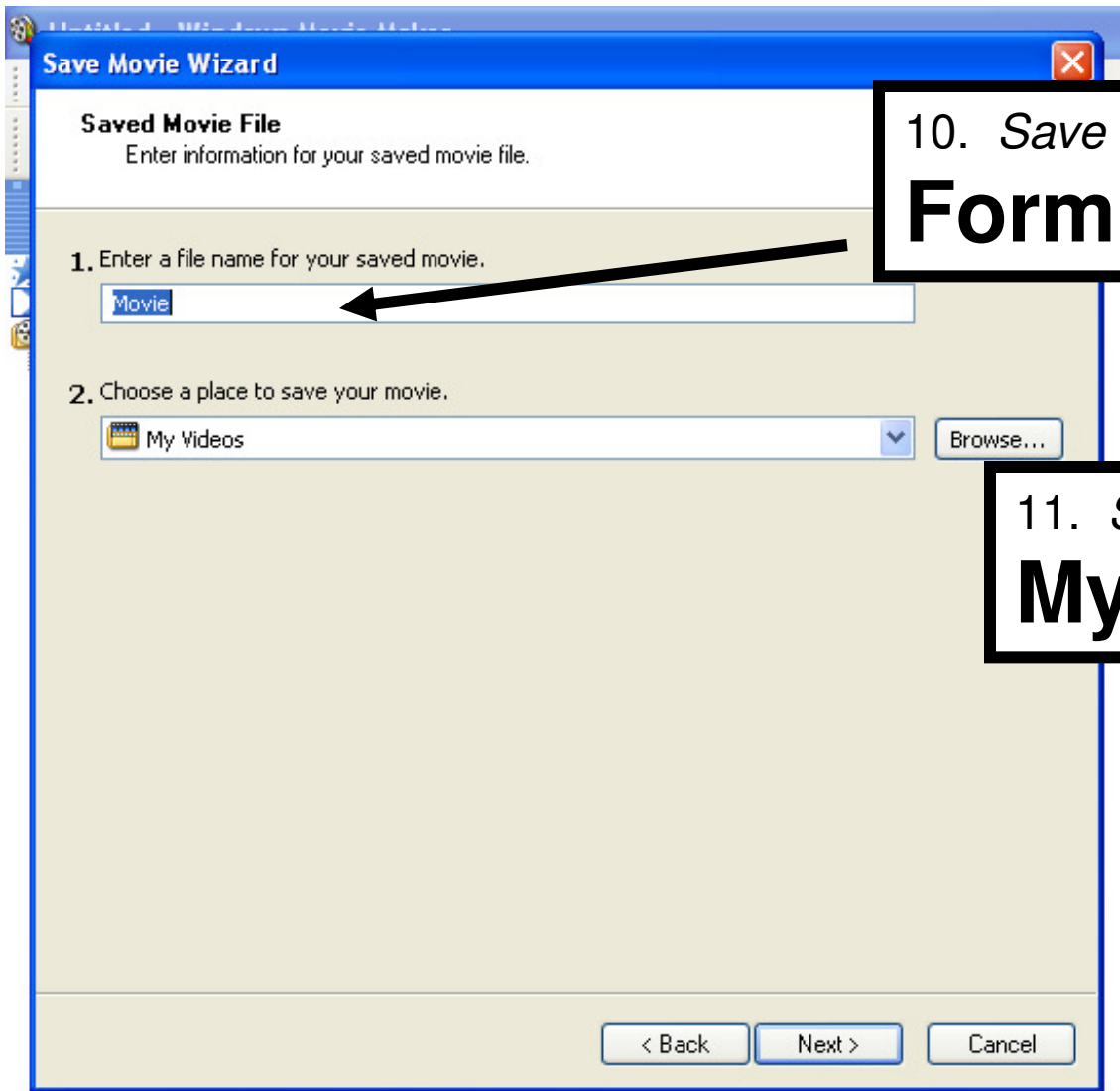

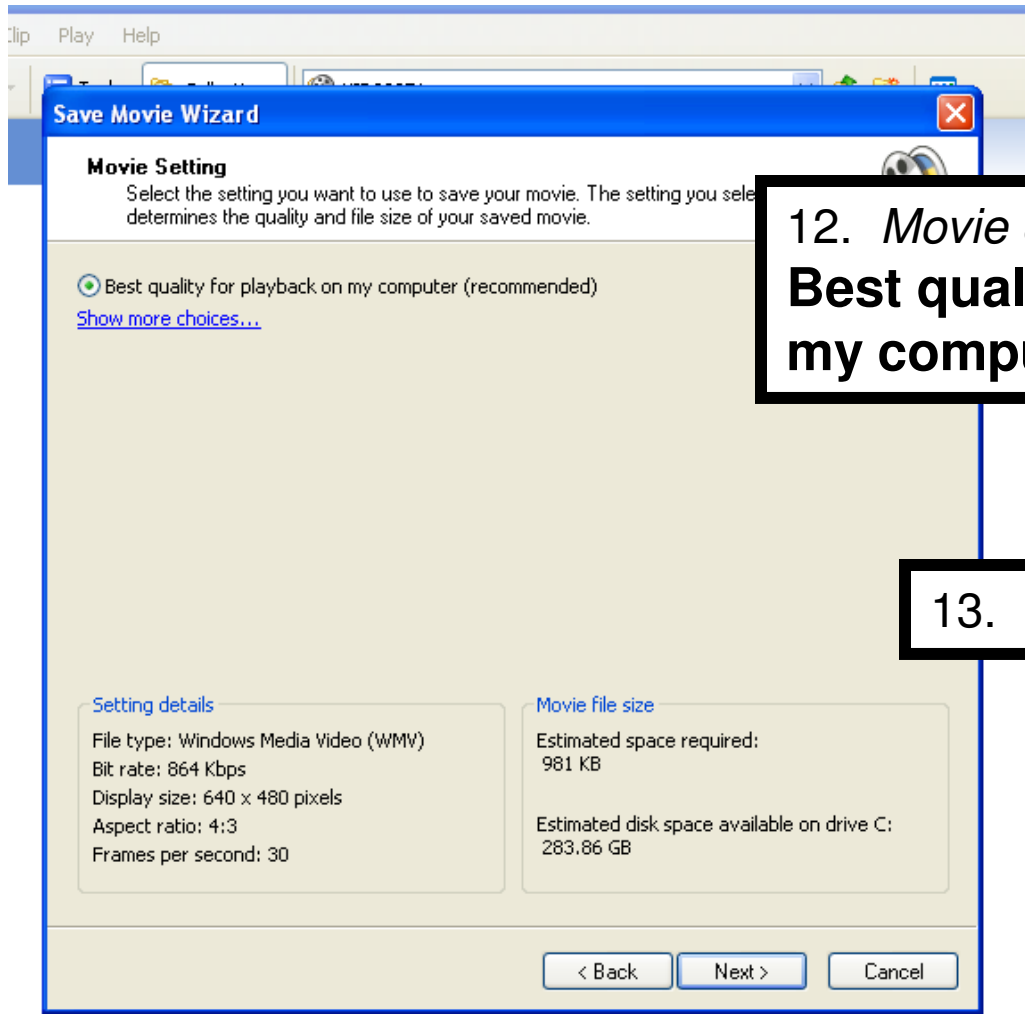
